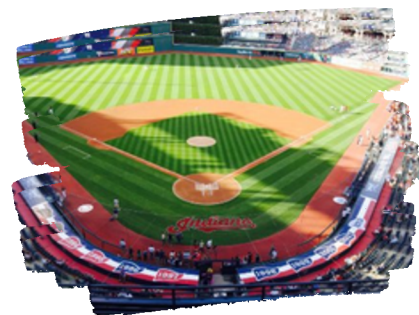

Hinchcliffe Stadium was constructed as a public works project, the Stadium was completed and dedicated in 1932. This art deco style structure, designed by architect John Shaw, was the result of the vision and perseverance of Paterson's then Mayor, John V. Hinchcliffe. In March 2013, Hinchcliffe Stadium was added as a National Historic Landmark. This designation was due to the Stadium's strong connection to Negro Leagues Baseball.
