2:30 pm Arrive Seminary Ridge Museum- Museum and Cupola Tour**

Take a guided walking tour where you will discover the actions of Gettysburg's first day of fighting. Visit three floors of immersive exhibits, stunning artifact displays. Explore the mile long interpretive battlefield walking trail. Tour the Cupola where the first day's battle was planned, observed. (Cupola not handicapped accessible).

4:30pm Visit the Jennie Wade House **- *Learn the story of the only civilian to be killed during the Battle of Gettysburg. Authentically furnished from cellar to attic, the Jennie Wade House is a shrine to Jennie and to life during the American Civil War. The Jennie Wade House features artifacts from that fatal day in 1863.*

Step on guided tour of the battlefield . The Battle of Gettysburg was a turning point in the Civil War, the Union victory that ended General Robert E. Lee's second and most ambitious invasion of the North. Gettysburg was the Civil War's bloodiest battle and was also the inspiration for President Abraham Lincoln's immortal "Gettysburg Address"

10:00 am Return to the Visitor Center for Cyclorama, Museum **

French artist Paul Philippoteaux and a team of assistants spent more than a year to complete this breathtaking canvas that measures 377 feet in circumference and 42 feet high. The museum features artifacts of the Battle of Gettysburg and personalities who served in the Civil War, interactive exhibits, and multimedia presentations that cover the conflict from beginning to end.

12:30 pm Arrive Emmitsburg, MD.. Shrine of Elizabeth Seton**

*Box lunch and tour***

Elizabeth Ann Seton was the first American Saint and she dedicated her life to educating and caring for the poor and marginalized. On this tour we will also learn more about her role in the battle at Gettysburg.

Browse the shops for your souvenirs. Gettysburg is one of the most iconic historical destinations. Visitors are drawn, not only by the history but by the small-town hospitality, the beautiful scenery and all of the shops, restaurants, wineries and the farmer's market.

Tour of the house, grounds and barn.
The farm served as Major General Edward Johnson's staging area for the Confederate attack on Culp's Hill, and was used as a Confederate Field Hospital during the battle.

 7:30 pm Arrive at Dinner at Hickory Bridge Farm Restaurant**
At the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains, Hickory Bridge Farm located in a beautifully restored barn that is over 160 years old. Hickory Bridge Farm is well known for their hospitality and their delicious dinners. All farm dinners include American foods that were favored by the area's German settlers and are family recipes.
